Resourcing CMS Ireland

CMS Ireland is a Christian Mission organisation that works in partnership with the Church, to share the Gospel throughout the world. We currently work with Global Partners in Africa, Asia and Europe, supporting them as they engage in holistic mission within their contexts, bringing hope, healing and transformation.

Financial giving is one of the main ways of engaging in the work of CMS Ireland and providing support for our partners. Very often, there is a desire to target such giving for a specific partner or project, and we welcome such 'designated' support. **Every** pound or Euro you commit in this way will go to the partner/project in question. However, we would also encourage you to consider giving towards CMS Ireland's Resource Fund. This fund allows us flexibility to cover shortfalls in partner/programme support and ensures that we can continue helping the Church to Love God and Love Others.

Standing Orders

By far the most effective way of giving, and the most helpful way for us to receive, donations, is via regular contributions from your bank or building society. A standing order form is attached to this leaflet. Please return the completed form to the CMS Ireland office in Belfast.

Gift Aid (UK)

Your donation could be worth almost 20% more - at no extra cost to you. The UK government currently gives CMS Ireland an extra 25 pence for every £1 which is donated - if you are a UK tax payer who completes the Gift Aid form. All you have to do is complete the form opposite, return it to our Belfast office and we will do the rest.

Tax Efficient Giving (Republic of Ireland)

Your donation could be worth approximately 69% more - at no extra cost to you. If you pay PAYE income tax in the Republic of Ireland, and donate more than €250 in a tax year, CMS Ireland can claim tax relief on your donation. If you pay tax at the standard rate, we can claim back an extra 25% of the value of your gift. This rises to approximately 69% if you pay tax at the higher 41% rate.
