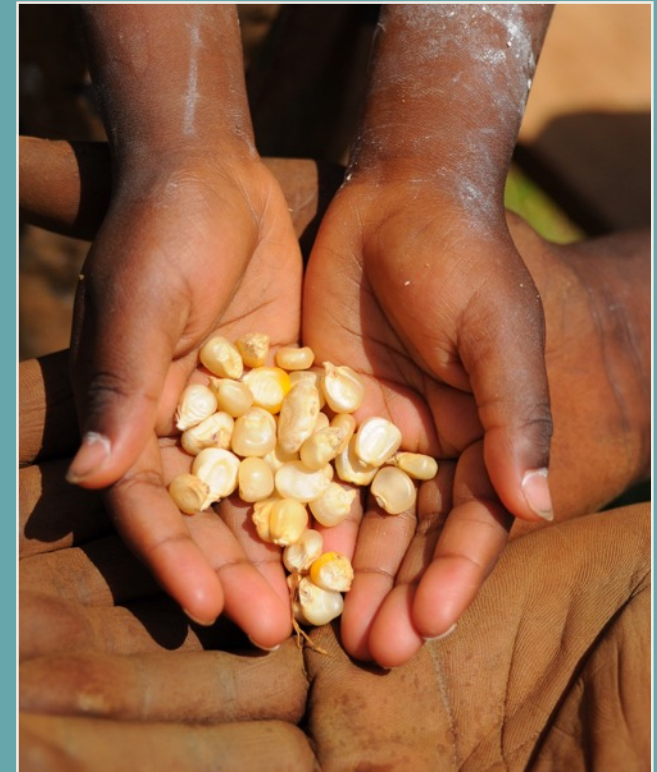

The Church Mission Society Ireland is a Christian mission organisation that exists to help God's people engage in God's mission. We make connections between different parts of God's global family and we equip churches and individuals to share God's transforming love.

We're hugely grateful for every donation made to CMSI and we do all we can to ensure money is properly managed and effectively used. We trust God to make money count, producing fruit from these offerings.

Money donated to CMSI falls into two broad categories:

- **Designated Giving** is targeted towards a specific partner or project. We operate a **100% policy** on such giving - no administrative fees or levies are applied by CMSI.
- **Unrestricted Giving** to our **General Fund** gives us flexibility to cover shortfalls in partner support, to invest time and resources in developing partnership links and to work with churches throughout Ireland. Such giving also covers the costs of international transfers and of monitoring the use of these funds.

## Standing Orders

The most effective - and helpful - way of giving financially to CMSI is via regular contributions direct from your bank or building society. A Standing Order form is included in this leaflet. You can also set up a Standing Order on our website.

## Gift Aid (UK)

The UK Government's Gift Aid scheme means CMSI can reclaim tax on donations. If you are a UK taxpayer, you simply need to complete the attached Gift Aid form and return it to our Belfast office. This will significantly increase any recent or future donations to CMSI, at no extra cost to yourself.

## Tax Efficient Giving (Republic of Ireland)

If you pay income tax in the Republic of Ireland and donate more than €250 to CMSI in a tax year, we can claim tax relief on your donation. This significantly increases your donation, at no extra cost to you. You simply sign an enduring certificate (valid for five years) or an annual certificate. Both forms are available on the CMSI website or on request from our offices.

*Tax claimed by CMSI via Gift Aid or Tax Efficient Giving is allocated to the Unrestricted Fund to use as most needed, including processing and monitoring designated donations.*
