Resourcing CMS Ireland

CMS Ireland is a network of Christians passionately committed to follow the call of Jesus Christ. We express this by facilitating mission through the local church in Ireland and across the world, living a lifestyle of discipleship and obedience. Currently we work in partnership with the church in Africa, Asia and Europe.

For many the support of a particular project or person is the main object of their giving. We appreciate and understand this and you can 'ring fence' such giving by completing the appropriate section opposite. However, CMS Ireland needs your help as we continue to explore and develop new mission opportunities as well as to provide the necessary additional resourcing for existing partners. We would ask you to consider giving generously to unrestricted funds.

Standing Order

Making regular contributions directly from your bank will help us to budget and plan our work more effectively. To do this, simply complete the standing order form opposite and return to the CMS Ireland office.

Gift Aid: UK

Your donation could be worth almost 30% more - at no extra cost to you. The UK government currently gives CMS Ireland £2.80 in addition to every £10 you give - if you are a UK tax payer who completes the Gift Aid form. All you have to do is complete the form and we will do the rest.

Tax Efficient Giving: Republic of Ireland

Your donation could be worth up to 72% more - at no extra cost to you. If you pay PAYE income tax in the Republic of Ireland, and donate more than €250 in a tax year, CMS Ireland can claim tax relief on your donation. If you pay tax at the standard 20% rate, we can claim back an extra 25% of the value of your gift. This rises to 72% if you pay tax at the higher 42% rate.
