The Church Mission Society Ireland is a Christian Mission organisation that exists to help God's people engage in God's mission. We facilitate two-way relationships between the Church of Ireland and our Global Partners in Africa and Nepal.

Financial giving is one of the main ways of engaging with the work of CMS Ireland and providing support for our partners. We are hugely grateful for every donation we receive and do all we can to ensure money is properly managed and effectively used. We trust God to make money count, producing fruit from these offerings.

Money donated to CMSI falls into two broad categories:

- **Designated Giving** is targeted towards a specific partner or project. **Every** pound or Euro given in this way is used in support of the purpose for which it has been given.
- **Unrestricted Giving** to our 'General Fund' gives us flexibility to cover shortfalls in partner/project support, to invest time and resources in developing mission partnerships and to work with churches throughout Ireland. Such giving also covers the costs of international transfers and of monitoring the use of these funds.

There are many different ways of giving financially to CMSI. Further details are available from our offices or our website.

Standing Orders

By far the most effective way of giving financially, and the most helpful for us, is via regular contributions direct from your bank or building society. A Standing Order form is included in this leaflet. You can also set up a Standing Order via the CMSI website.

Gift Aid (UK)

The UK Government's **Gift Aid** scheme means CMSI can reclaim tax on donations. If you are a UK taxpayer, all you have to do is fill in the attached Gift Aid form and return it to our Belfast office. Doing this will significantly increase any recent donations or future donations to CMSI, at no extra cost to yourself.

Tax Efficient Giving (Republic of Ireland)

If you pay PAYE Income Tax in the Republic of Ireland and donate more than **€250** to CMSI in a tax year, we can claim tax relief on your donation. This significantly increases your donation, at no extra cost to yourself. The process currently requires charities to identify eligible donors each year. CMSI staff will send the information and forms to all relevant donors.

Tax claimed by CMSI via Gift Aid or Tax Efficient Giving is allocated to the Unrestricted Fund to use as most needed, including processing and monitoring designated donations.

Gift Aid Form (UK)

Gift Aid Declaration
