Madi West Nile Diocese

GENERAL PRAYERS

Mo 1. Praise God for making all things new. As this first day of 2024 unfolds, pray that God would help all of us be open to new ways of hearing, seeing and being part of God's work on the ground.

PROVINCE OF ALEXANDRIA

Tu 2. The Diocese of Egypt celebrated the opening of the first office for the Global South Fellowship of Anglicans, in Cairo, last year. Pray for Archbishop Samy and also Archbishop Justin of South Sudan as this new office develops.



We 3. Archbishop Samy recently baptised fifty-two new members at the Sudanese Congregation at All Saints' Cathedral in Cairo. Pray for these new church members and the community who have welcomed them

Th 4. Pray for the staff at Refuge Egypt as they seek to manage limited resources and medical care for so many newcomers arriving in Cairo. Pray that each person seeking help will find it in the community and care of God's people.

Fr 5. Today we remember the work and ministry of Christ the King Parish in Alexandria and Rev Mina, along with his leadership team. Pray for strength and resources to work to the vision God has given the church in Alexandria.

GENERAL PRAYERS

Sa 6. As we remember the visit of the Magi to Jesus and his parents, pray that God would continue to reveal himself to the world through the global church.

Su 7. Praise God that, by the Holy Spirit, we are all invited to join as "members of the same body and share in the promise that God made through Christ Jesus." *Ephesians 3:6*

RWANDA

Mo 8. Pray for rain in Rwanda as it has been affected by the ongoing severe drought throughout the Horn of Africa; the 2023 rainy season did not bring enough precipitation. Pray that God may give sufficient rain for crops, grasses for livestock and water for irrigation.

Shyogwe Diocese

Tu 9. Praise God for the recent visit of Bishop Jered Kalimba to Ireland, where he was hosted by friends and parishes in both the Republic and in Northern Ireland. He also attended the Ignite Conference speaking powerfully about reconciliation and the importance of cell groups.



We 10. Pray for the innovative businesses the diocese is developing, including the Energy Saving Stove project, the water-filter project and the Pineapple Juice Factory. Ask the Lord for wisdom as they expand their reach seeking to benefit the community in a sustainable way.
