Materials:

- Craft Template
- Colouring Utensils
- Scissors


Instructions:

- Print off template.
- Colour the flower stages and the flower scene.
- Cut out the strip of flower stages. Just along the outside. (Don't cut each individual stage out)
- Cut a slit in the scene along the dotted line.
- Pull the strip through the slit and watch the flower grow.

Tips:

- When printing, make sure you "fit to page" so everything makes it on the page.
- Discuss how to help grow a healthy faith.




Session 4
