Would you like to join hands in mission with inspirational individuals serving God in their own contexts?




**Toti Jacob Finosa**, from South Sudan, is the founder and director of the Christian Mission Empowerment Centre. He lives with his wife, Grace, and family in Kyangwali.

Toti works with a committee to support a nursery and primary school in the camp, regular Bible studies and fellowship meetings, a women's empowerment group, skills training in pig-keeping and tailoring. The CMEC is also establishing a vocational training centre. The majority of people in the settlement have fled violence in DRC.



Activities include youth conferences, outreach events, Christian radio programmes, youth leader training, practical skills for employment, Christian family life teaching and Bible studies. SLM works collaboratively with local churches.

**Bishop Hassan** ministers in a particularly hostile part of Sudan. The Nuba Mountain region, which lies along the Sudan/South Sudan border, is rich in diversity of people groups and mineral resources. A contested space since early 1980s, air bombardments and land offensives continue as the government tries to control the region.

Support Bishop Hassan as he works towards peace, trying to mitigate the impact of conflict on the communities he serves.
